Air Travel

Pellston Regional Airport (PLN) offers daily commercial flights through Detroit (DTW), and is located just 17 miles/20 minutes from the ferry docks. Serviced by Delta Airlines, and with 2-4 flights arriving daily, it is the most convenient way to get to Mackinac Island.

Shepler's offers ferry service every 15, 30, or 60 minutes, depending on the season. Boats leave from Mackinaw City and St. Ignace with seamless luggage delivery directly to your guest room from the mainland dock.
